Get Health Insurance Through Your Job

If you're working and can get health insurance through your job, you may be able to enroll outside its yearly Open Enrollment Period if you lose your parent's coverage. Contact your human resources representative before turning 26 for your next steps.

Get a Marketplace Insurance Plan

At www.marketplace.virginia.gov, you'll find a variety of plans and prices available to you. Depending on your situation, you may be eligible for savings based on your income. See if you'll save at www.marketplace.virginia.gov/financial-savings.

When Can You Apply?

- **If you're aging off your parent's Marketplace plan:** You can stay on your parent's plan until coverage ends December 31 even if you turn 26-mid-year. Remember to enroll in a Marketplace plan of your own before the Open Enrollment deadline. **Open Enrollment runs from November 1 - January 15 each year.**
- **If you're aging off your parent's job-based plan:** Your coverage usually ends the month you turn 26. Even if it's outside Open Enrollment, losing other coverage qualifies you for a Special Enrollment Period (SEP). You'll have 60 days before you lose coverage and an additional 60 days after that to enroll before the SEP deadline.

Get Medicaid Coverage

To see if you may qualify, visit coverva.org or call 1-855-242-8282. You can also visit your local Department of Social Services. You can apply for Medicaid at any time.
